# Literacy

To know our Talk for Writing text

## To write letters with the correct formation

To know that words in a sentence have a 'finger space' between them

To write letters on a line

#### Number

- To recognise quantities up to 5 by sight, without needing to count.
- To automatically recall the following number bonds to 5:

5+0, 0+5, 4+1, 1+4, 2+3, 3+3 5-0=5, 5-4=1, 5-1=4, 5-3=2, 5-2=3

- To know some number bonds to 10 e.g 9+1, 8+2
- To know the following double facts:
  1+1=2, 2+2=4, 3+3=6, 4+4=8, 5+5=10
- Verbally count beyond 20
- To compare quantities of objects and to be able to say when one is greater than, less than or the same as another

#### **Phonics**

## All children:

To read and write the phonemes in Speed Sounds Set 1:

masdtinpgockckubf elhshrjvywthzchqux ngnkllssffzz

## Green, Pink & Purple groups:

To read and write the following Set 2 phonemes:

ay ee igh ow (as in snow) oo (long) oo (short) ar or air ir ou (as in shout) ov

To read and write 'red' words they encounter in their reading during phonics.

These may include the following:

I of the put my he she your said you be no are

To apply the sounds and words above to their reading and writing.

To write simple sentences independently.

## **Understanding the World**

To know that living things change and grow

To know some of the basic elements that plants need in order to grow e.g light

To know that they can eat some plants but not others To identify different farm animals and their features

To know the names of farm animals, eg sow, boar, piglet.

To know the life cycle of a frog and a caterpillar

To know that an insect has six legs, thorax and abdomen

## Please note:

In order to achieve the expected standard at the end of the year, children must be confident in the areas in **bold type**.

To achieve the expected level in phonics, children must be confident in reading and writing all Set 1 sounds and at least four Set 2 sounds. Using the sounds they know, they must also be able to write short sentences independently.
