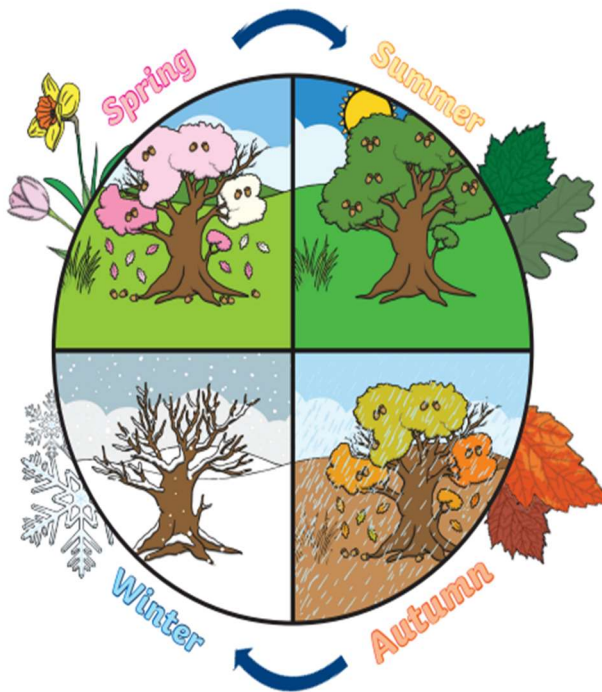

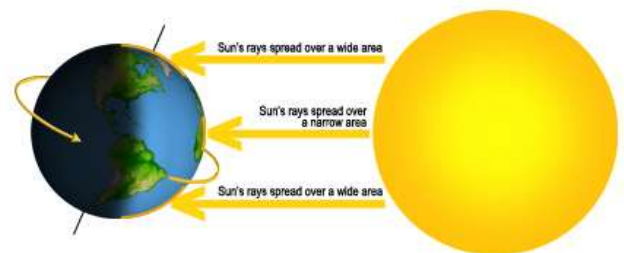

What are the 4 seasons and why do they occur?

- In the United Kingdom we have 4 seasons: Spring, Summer, Autumn and Winter.
- The weather in each season is different. In summer it is hotter and the days last longer. In Winter it is colder, and the days are shorter.
- The amount of light we get in a day varies according to the



season - this is because the Earth tilts.
