Tier 3 Vocabulary

Portrait	A picture of a person, usually showing the person's face.
Texture	In a painting, texture describes an artist making a 2D surface look layered or bumpy and not flat - even though it is.
Collage	A piece of art made from different pieces of paper, photos and other materials.
Shade	A shade is where an artist adds black to a colour to darken it down. A tone is where an artist adds grey to a colour.
Still life drawing	A still life is a drawing or painting that focuses on still objects.
