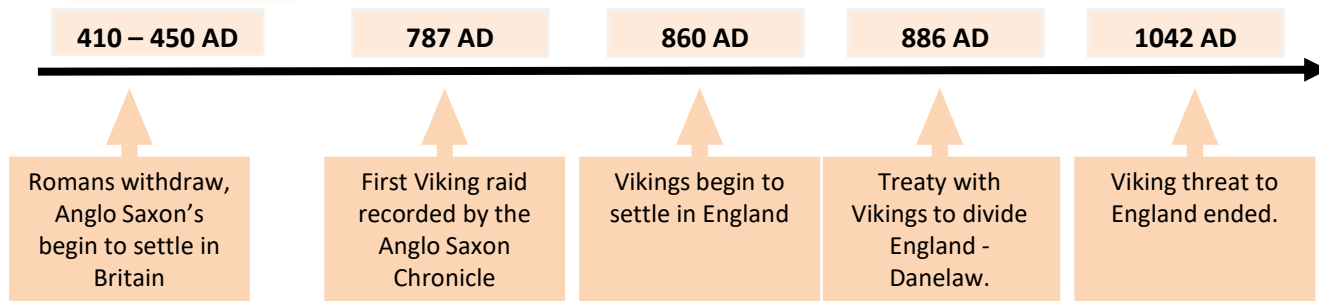


Knowledge Organiser Year 3 History: Anglo Saxons and Vikings

Key People

Anglo-Saxons	The Angles, Saxons, and Jutes who settle in Britain from Denmark and Northern Germany
Scots	Descendants of the Picts from Ireland, divided Scotland into 4 kingdoms and were a constant threat to Britons.
Vikings	Invaded Britain from Scandinavia to pillage land and gold.



Tier 3 Vocabulary

Kingdom	An area of land ruled by a king or queen.
Settlement	A small community of people living together.
Monastery	A place where monks live, work and pray.
Longship	A long, narrow warship, powered by both oar and sail with many rowers, used by the Vikings. Features of a longship include: figurehead, prow, keel, hull, rudder, oar and clinker-building.
Pagan	Someone who believed in many gods
Pillage	To take something using violence.
