| Personal Social & Emotional Development  | Physical Development   | Communication and Language  |
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| This half term, the children will be learning how to recognise<br>their own feelings and who might support them. They will<br>also consider how to take care of their environment Linking<br>to the Growing and Changing topic, the children will also be<br>thinking about how to take care of plants and animals.  | Within class we will continue to focus on ensuring that<br>children are developing their fine motor skills for effective<br>handwriting. The children will continue to develop their<br>ability to write on a line and we will focus on controlling<br>letter size.<br>Within P.E lessons we will be covering multiskills and team<br>games. We will be developing our ball skills and use of P.E<br>equipment such as bats. | This term our focus will be on children understanding and<br>using both new topic vocabulary and RVI words (see below).<br>We will also be encouraging children to listen carefully to<br>their peers and begin to teach them how to build on what<br>another person has said.  |
| Literacy   | Mathematics  | Understanding the World   |
| Children will continue to develop their writing. They will be<br>applying their knowledge of phonics to their writing. They<br>will be encouraged to write in sentences, beginning to use<br>capital letters and full stops. We will be teaching children the<br>capital letters.<br>In reading children will be applying their phonic knowledge<br>to more complex words and extending their sight vocabulary<br>so that they can read with greater fluency.<br>Children will be working on phonics in their Read, Write Inc<br>groups. | This half term we will be looking at doubling, halving and<br>sharing. Children will also work on consolidating their<br>knowledge of number bonds to ten and counting to 20 and<br>beyond.  | Children will be learning about the lifecycles of animals such<br>as butterflies and frogs. They will be able to identify farm<br>animals and their young. Children will also be learning how<br>to identify different animal habitats. The children will learn<br>how to identify different types of mini beast.<br>We will also plant a variety of seeds and we will be learning<br>about what a seed needs in order to grow. |
