

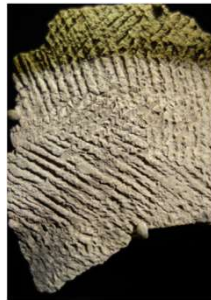


Year 3 DT - Clay Containers
