Accessing Individual Learning Plans (ILPs)

Step 1 – Access <https://edukeyapp.com/parent/login>

ASSESS: If you scroll down the screen you will see a summary of strengths and areas relating to your child's SEND. This section is written and updated by your child's class teacher.

ATTAINMENT: This section contains any current assessment data gathered by the school. For current maths, writing and reading levels we record a number followed by WTS (Working Towards), EXS (Expected level) or GDS (Working at Greater Depth).

For example;

3WTS	The pupil is currently working towards the standard expected at the end of Year 3 in that subject.
1EXS	The pupil is currently working at the expected standard for a Year 1 pupil in that subject.
5GDS	The pupil is currently working at greater depth standard for a pupil in Year 5 in that subject

For some pupils, more specific assessments are also completed and recorded as referenced below.

Reading Accuracy	Assesses the accuracy of the child's reading of a given text
Reading Comprehension	Assesses the child's understanding of what is being read
Reading Rate	Assesses the child's reading speed
PHAB	Assesses and identifies children who have significant phonological difficulties and need additional help to process sounds in spoken language.
Sandwell Maths	Assesses a child's ability with numbers and numerical understanding
Working Memory	Assesses if a child may have difficulty with their working memory

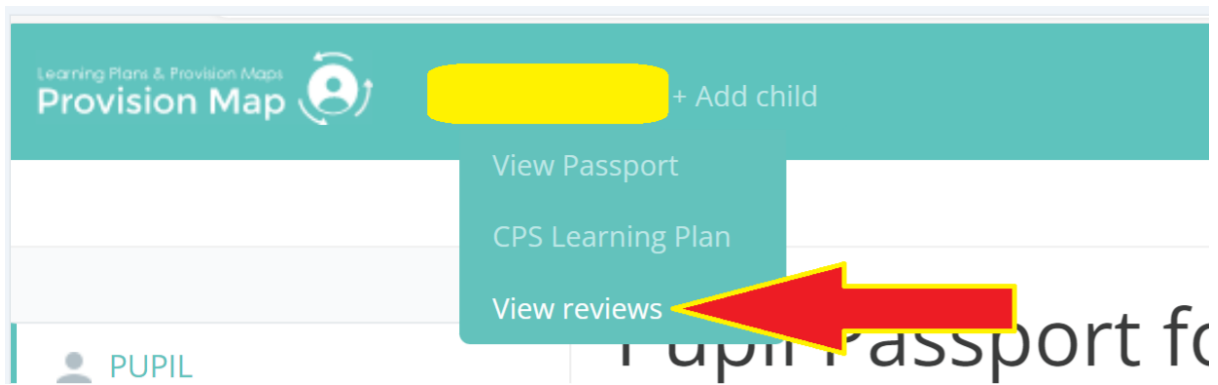
