



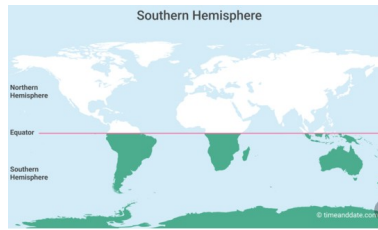

### Key facts

Australia has a varied climate. The central out-back is hot and dry. Most of the people in Australia live near the coast.
