

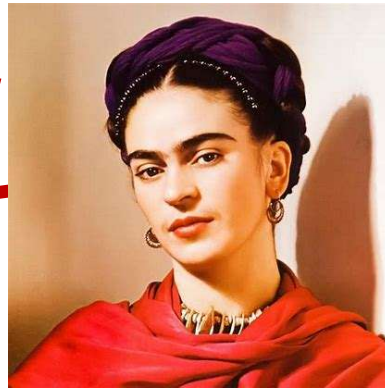


Knowledge Organiser for Year 3 Art Topic: Frida Kahlo

She was inspired by traditional Mexican culture.

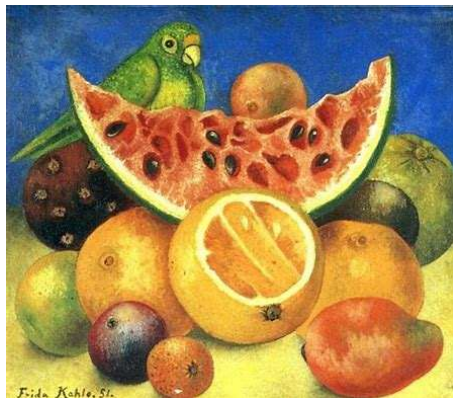


Frida Kahlo

She was a part of the Surrealist movement.

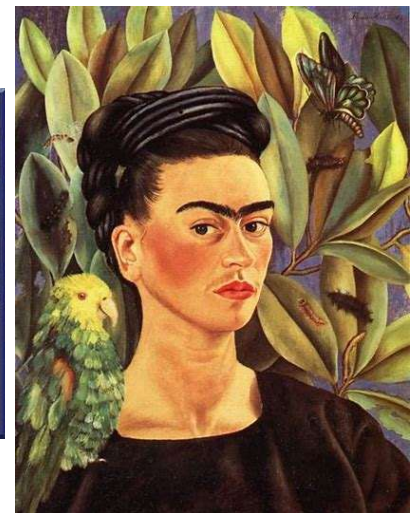
Frida was a style icon.

Tier 3 Vocabulary

Surrealism	Surrealism is a style of art inspired by dreams and hidden thoughts.
Mexican Folk Art	It is colourful and creative. It reflects Mexican culture.
Self-Portrait	A portrait that the artist produces of themselves.
Block Colour	Using and exploring colours that are opposites on the colour wheel.
Primary Colours	The three primary colours are red, yellow and blue.
Secondary Colours	A colour resulting from the mixing of two primary colours.
