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| Proportion | Proportion refers to the dimensions of a composition and relationships between height, width and depth. |
| Stylised drawing | Stylization refers to a visual depiction, which represents an object without a full attempt and accurate representation of an object's realistic appearance. |
| Accurate Drawing | Accurate drawing can be defined as the drawing being true, correct, or exact. It is the proximity of a measurement result to true value. |



'The 2000 Yard Stare' Thomas Lea - 1944

Thomas Lea

July 11, 1907 – January 29, 2001

A famous American War Artist and muralist.

Won multiple awards and honours of recognition for his realistic and impactful depictions of WW2 in the South Pacific .

Guernica

Created by Pablo Picasso, a Spanish painter, sculptor, printmaker and ceramicist.

Painter of the anti-war painting Guernica (1937), a dramatic portrayal of the bombing of Guernica by German and Italian air forces during the Spanish Civil War.

Picasso's artistic style did not fit the Nazi ideal of art, so he did not exhibit during this time. He was often harassed by the Gestapo. **During one search of his apartment, an officer saw a photograph of the painting *Guernica*. "Did you do that?" the German asked Picasso. "No," he replied, "You did."**
