Teabag Textiles Art Scroll

Melanie Missin

Make a textured scroll, with used teabags, free motion machine stitching, and a water-soluble material to create 3D pieces and painting. You will need to have a basic knowledge of free motion stitching, a sewing machine in good working order with a darning foot, a selection of plain or variegated coloured cotton machine threads, sewing kit and apron. All other materials will be supplied at \pounds 7.00 per person payable during the course. **3 Days** (Mon – Wed), 10am – 4pm, £168

Eco Dyeing Express

A wonderful introduction to eco dyeing. Day one will be spent printing leaves onto fabric and paper using different leaves, making as many prints as we can, ready for day two. The second day will be the stitching day, using the sewing machine to outline the leaves and adding hand stitching for decoration. The edges will be cut with a soldering iron and we will look at how to hang the pieces once finished. Materials extra.

Spectacular Studio Screen Printing

A fantastic three days of discovery as you learn different techniques for screen printing onto cloth. This medium is colourful, adaptable, and amazingly fast. We will be using water-based inks and non-toxic fillers wherever possible. Each day, different methods for creating a design on the screen will be introduced and students will have the opportunity to experiment with ideas that suit their own style of working. This course is ideal for people who want to experiment with print, pattern, and graphic styles. **3 Days** (Mon – Weds), 10am-4pm, £168



Screen Print with Dyes – Experimental

Ricki Outis

A special two-day screen printing course, focussing on screen printing with thickened dyes onto cloth. This is particularly useful for printing on lightweight cottons and silks because it maintains the softness, shine, and drape of the fabric. The course will include direct printing of cold-water dyes onto fabric, as well as 'deconstructed' or breakdown screen printing onto cloth, creating wonderful textures and magical effects. Ideal for textile artists who love experimenting with unexpected and serendipitous outcomes. **2 Days** (Thurs – Fri), 10am – 4pm, £112



Weaving on a 4 Shaft Table Loom

Anna Crutchley

Suitable for beginners and weavers with previous experience. Beginners will sample a variety of weave structures, experimenting with colour combinations, yarn qualities and surface textures. More experienced weavers are encouraged to discuss their ideas with the tutor in advance. You'll leave with a full set of samples, notes and information for further progress. Materials provided by Tutor, approx £10-£20 extra.
