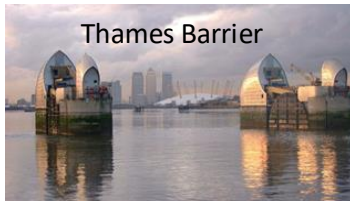
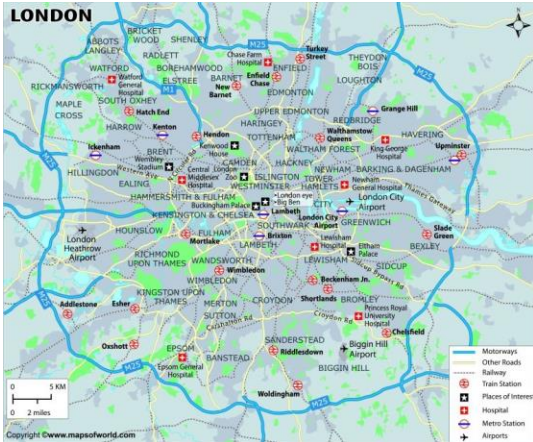


Knowledge Organiser Year 5/6 Geography: London & South-East England

Tier 3 Vocabulary

Region	A part of a country that is different or separate from other parts in some way. England is divided into 8 regions.
County	An area of a country that is larger than a city and has its own government to deal with local matters
Metropolitan	Relating to a large city.
Population	The number of people living in a certain area.
Tidal	Connected with the tides (the regular rising and falling of the sea)



Key geographical features – London

Capital city of England	
County	Greater London 32 London boroughs + City of London
Population	9.5 million (largest city in England)
Area	1500 km ²
Rivers	Thames – tidal in London

Key geographical features – South-East England

Counties	Kent, East & West Sussex, Hampshire, Isle of Wight, Surrey, Berkshire, Buckinghamshire, Oxfordshire
Cities & towns	Southampton, Portsmouth, Brighton, Canterbury, Reading, Oxford, Milton Keynes
Population	9 million+
Area	19,000 km ²
River	Thames – 346 km, second longest river in the UK
