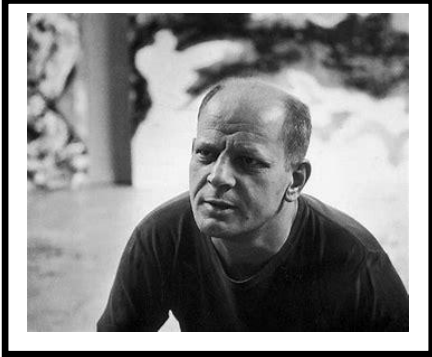




Knowledge Organiser for EYFS – Expressive Arts Autumn Term

Artist Autumn 1: Jackson Pollock



Jackson Pollock

Born: 1912 Wyoming USA
Died: 1956 New York City USA

Jackson Pollock created *abstract* art. This meant that his paintings did not look like anything. They showed emotions such as happiness or anger.



This painting is called *Summertime, Number 9A* and was painted in 1948.

Jackson Pollock created his paintings by dripping paint onto large *canvases* on the floor. This was sometimes called *action painting*.
