### Grafham Activity Days for Year 5: Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> and Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> July

Dear Year 5 Parents and Guardians,

I just wanted to send out a bit of information about the up-coming Grafham trip:

- Children need to be in school for 8.15am and they will need to come straight to the Hall.
- They will return at approximately 4.15pm and they will all need to be collected from school.
- Children will need a packed lunch for **both of the days**. This can be ordered from the school caterers by using the link below. Orders for packed lunches must be made by Friday 26<sup>th</sup> June.

- They **must** have a bottle of water (which can be refilled at Grafham).
- Children should be dressed in outdoor clothes for any weather with sensible shoes e.g. trainers that they don't mind getting wet or dirty.
- Children must have **two pairs** of shoes, one of these being an enclosed pair (no flip-flops) suitable for water activities e.g. old trainers/beach shoes.
- They will need a **full change of clothes** each day and a plastic bag to put wet, muddy clothes in.
- Children will need a swimsuit or wet suit and a towel in a separate bag each day as all of the activities are water-based.
- Sun cream should be applied before coming to school and they should bring sun cream, a named hat or waterproof (dependent on the weather).

The high expectations we have of behaviour at school will remain the same whilst at Grafham and we will be reminding all of the children about their responsibilities. We would welcome and appreciate your support with this. In line with our risk assessments, we will be supervising the children closely along with the staff at Grafham. However, if, for any reason, your child's behaviour shows cause for concern or poses a risk to either themselves or others, please be aware that we will contact you and require you to collect your child from Grafham immediately. This will be in order to safeguard all children involved in the trip.

We hope that all of the children are looking forward to their time at Grafham; we are certainly looking forward to sharing the experiences they will have there.
