

## Year 3 Science Knowledge Organiser The Human Body- Digestive System

Tier 3 Vocabulary	Meaning
Digestion	The process by which the body breaks down food for energy,
Macronutrients	Carbohydrates, fats and proteins.
Incisor	To incise means to cut. These teeth make the initial cut of your food.
Canine	From the Latin word for dog, these teeth tear your food into pieces.
Premolar	Teeth used to crush food.
Molar	Molars are used to grind food into small enough pieces to swallow.
Oesophagus	The muscular tube that links your throat to your stomach.
Stomach	A large muscle designed to hold and mix up the food you eat.
Intestines	Long coiled up tube through which your digested food travels.
