The Team

- Big Transition for Year 1s
- Work is often desk based. Expectation that answers are framed, more teacher directed.
- 3 weeks in Classes getting to know new teachers
- Reduction in curriculum content to allow half an hour story time at the end of each day
- Increase in practical maths activities for Year 1 at the start of the year
- Change to English curriculum to allow a more gradual build-up of skills

Supporting Transition

- Daily Maths, English and Phonics in groups
- Afternoons: History, Geography, Science, PE, Music, PSHE or RE
- Two play times
- Reading- two times a week in class and two times a week in groups
- Assembly each day

How is a day structured?

- Single Year teaching for Maths and English
- Some Year 2 children may access Year 1 curriculum for Maths and English
- Regular liaison meetings between the two teachers
- Groups will start week after next
- Letter to confirm teacher

How are the children grouped for Maths and English?

- Taught daily
- Year 1 Children have just been assessed
- Year 2 children will largely access a spelling programme with phonics as needed
- Assessed regularly

Phonics


- Write daily
- Every unit has a 'real' text which the children will be exposed to
- Focus on sentence level skills
- Aim: by the end of Year 2 all children will write in accurate sentences, punctuated with !? or . and begin to use conjunctions (because, so but).



- Taught daily
- Aim for the children to be fluent in basic maths skills (mental addition and subtraction, multiplication and division) by the time they leave Year 2
- Maths workshops for parents 17th October



- This term: Geography and History of the Fens, The Seasons, Angie Lewin- Print Making, The Nutcracker, Festivals of Light
- Knowledge Organisers support with what children will be learning
- Embed key knowledge- lots of over learning, role play
- Trips and visitors- Ely Museum and Cathedral
- PE is taught twice weekly and PSHE weekly: Rules, Rights and Responsibilities, Gymnastics and Tennis

Topic work

- Change to homework this year to simplify it
- Aiming to consolidate basic skills

Homework

- Reading books changed weekly on a Monday
- 2 books/ 1 longer
- One decodable book. One trickier book to share
- Only receive new books if they have bought old ones back
- LRC- visited weekly
- Reading please send in on a Friday

Homework-Reading

- Termly 'red words' list will be sent home
- These are to learn at your leisure
- We will test every term and let you know which words your children don't yet spell accurately

Homework- Spelling/ Phonics

- Aiming to build fluency
- Children to access Numbots 4-5 times a week (5 minutes is fine) Teachers will be monitoring the uptake of this.
- Spend this time in Story Mode
- Speak to teachers if the pace is too fast or you can't access
 IT
- We will move Year 2 pupils on to Times Tables Rock Stars (TTRS) for homework once they have completed the latter stages

Homework- Maths

- Children will no longer sit SATS tests in KS1
- Phonics testing in Year 1

Statutory Testing

- Uniform- red and white t-shirts/red jumpers/ cardigans only
- All children to have a water bottle
- All clothing and water bottles (especially in PE kits) to be named
- No toys/ games/ additional books to be bought into school unless you have a prior arrangement with the teacher
