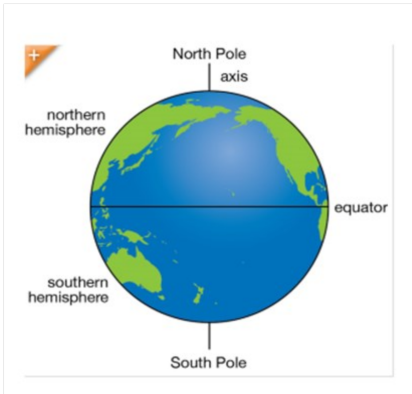




Knowledge Organiser for Year 1/2 Geography Topic: Comparing hot and cold places



The more sunlight a place gets, the hotter it will usually be. The amount and strength of sunlight we get depends on how far we are from the *Equator*.

Continent	A large solid area of land. There are seven in the world.
Equator	An imaginary line round the middle of a planet
Temperature	How hot or cold a place is
Weather	The daily temperature and rainfall
Climate	The typical weather conditions over several years.
Tourism	Tourism is when people travel from where they live to another place for pleasure or relaxation
